**Shooting :-** There will be four archers per boss in two details using foam bosses on H frames. All arrows will be shot in ends of 6 in 4 minutes over both days with the exception of the Head to Head on Saturday afternoon where ends / sets of arrows will be shot in ends of 3 in 2 minutes.

**Saturday** Recurve Archers will shoot 70m at a 122cm face and Compound Archers will shoot 50m at individual 80cm faces (5 to 10 zone scoring)

**Sunday** the 2 longer distances will be shot at 122cm faces. All disciplines will shoot on a 80cm 5 to 10 zone scoring using a 4 face set up at 50m & 30m with the exception of the Longbow Archers and all Metric rounds will shoot on a full size 80cm face for the duration of the afternoon. All disciplines controlled by lights.
