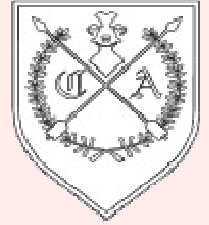

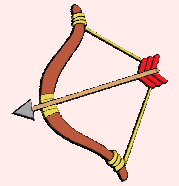

CLEVE JUNIOR OPEN TOURNAMENT 2018

Date: Saturday 2nd June 2018

Time: Assembly 10.15am. Sighters at 10.30am.

Location: "Up Yonder", Bury Hill, Hambrook, Bristol, BS16 1SS.
(A map and car parking arrangements will be sent out with the Target List)



Rounds: The tournament has **UK Record Status** for the Albion and all Windsor rounds.



Age Category	Round	Arrows
Any	Albion	3 dozen each at 80y, 60y and 50y
Boys U18	Windsor	3 dozen each at 60y, 50y and 40y
Boys U16 & Girls U18	Short Windsor	3 dozen each at 50y, 40y and 30y
Boys U14 & Girls U16	Junior Windsor	3 dozen each at 40y, 30y and 20y
Boys U12, Girls U14 & Girls U12	Short Junior Windsor	3 dozen each at 30y, 20y and 10y

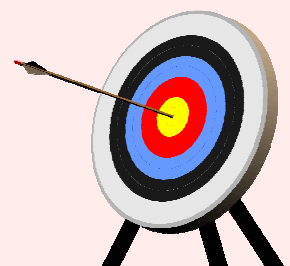
[Although shooting the same round, U12 Girls will not be competing against U14 Girls]

Juniors may enter rounds above their age group if desired and will be eligible for awards. Juniors may also enter rounds below their age group but will only be eligible for the handicap-based award.

Parents/Guardians of competing Juniors may enter the Albion round. Places for this will be limited to 1 boss (i.e. 4 parents).

Entry Fee: £8 per round – all archers. Any withdrawals after the advertised closing date will be non refundable. Spaces will not be reserved without full payment.

Closing Date for Entries: 26th May 2018. Early entry is advised as we can only accommodate a maximum of 48 archers.

Other bits and pieces

Registration:	From 9am on the day. Equipment inspection from 9.30am. Archers must be able to produce a valid Archery GB membership card or a letter from their Club confirming that affiliation fees have been paid. You will not be allowed to shoot without one of these two pieces of proof of affiliation.
Judge in Charge:	Mr. Richard Jones
Guest of Honour:	TBA
Awards:	<p>Best Gold: At some point during the shoot there will be two prizes for Best Gold (Recurve/Barebow/Longbow and Compound).</p> <p>Medals: Will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all Junior age/gender/bow categories regardless of the number of entries. There is unlikely to be anything for the parents. Sorry.</p> <p>Handicapped prizes: I am aiming to award a prize for the highest handicap-adjusted score, so please provide your handicap on the entry form.</p> <p>Trophies: I will endeavour to award trophies to all 1st placed Juniors.</p> <p>Teams: Team trophies will be awarded for the highest combined scores to a) a team of up to 3 Recurve archers from the same club, b) a team of up to 3 Compound archers from the same club and c) a parent/child team.</p> <p>Presentation of awards will take place as soon as possible after the end of shooting.</p>
Event Format:	Shooting will be on 122cm faces, 5-zone scoring. Shooting will be in timed ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes, in 2 details. Assistance on the day from parents with recording scores and adding-up would be appreciated. I may use a double-scoring system to help eliminate adding-up errors.
Dress Code:	All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307). Any archer not complying with these regulations may not be permitted to shoot.
Target List & Results:	The Target List and Results will be sent to entrants by e-mail. The final Results will also appear on Cleve Archers' website: www.cleavearchers.co.uk

Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached.
Photography:	Archery GB's Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy requires that anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first. The register will be available at the event.
Lost Arrows:	Any lost arrows which have not been located by the end of the shoot must be reported to the Judge in Charge. Metal detectors will be available.
Refreshments:	Will be available throughout the day.
Dogs:	Dogs are not permitted on the shooting field.
Smoking:	Smoking is not permitted on the shooting field. This includes e-cigarettes. Those wishing to smoke may do so in the car parking areas.
