Club Committee Vacancies

There are a number of vacancies on the club committee which need filling. A number of the club committee are currently doubling- or trebling-up on roles which means not everything gets done as promptly as we would like. We really need a few more hands to make the club run. This is particularly important at a time when we are busy with the redevelopment of our new field.

The positions we need filling are as follows – along with a rough outline of the role positions;

Equipment Officer

This is the most urgent role we need filling and consists of organising a team of people to help make repairs to targets and beginner's equipment. If we do not have any volunteers, members may find that they have to repair a target before shooting.

- The role of the Equipment Officer will be to organise, maintain and record all Club equipment with the help of a team of volunteers if required.
- Ensure that all Club equipment is maintained to an acceptable standard (with a team of volunteers if required).
- The equipment officer should also be responsible for the purchase, upon the committee's approval, any resources required by the Club.
- As with the rest of the committee positions, the Equipment Officer will be supported as and when required.

Health & Safety Officer

- To ensure accident and emergency procedures are in place and adhered to.
- To ensure the first aid kits are appropriately equipped.
- To ensure that the Club Management Committee are appraised of any Safety Issues that need resolution and members are kept informed as necessary.
- Ensure that a risk assessment is produced for the Club and reviewed at least every 12 months.
- Ensure that the Club accident book is present at the Club facilities and any accidents are properly recorded and reviewed.
- Ensure a practice 'fast' call is made at Junior Club at least once per month.

Social Secretary

- To motivate the Club members to join in all social activities.
- To arrange, organise, communicate and record all social activities in regard to the Club members.
- To coordinate catering for Club tournaments and beginner courses.
- The social secretary will be responsible for all aspects of the social side of the Club and its members and be able to rely on the other committee/club members to assist as and when circumstances dictate.

Secretary

UK Junior Masters

Three Junior archers from Cleve shot at the UK Junior Masters on 12th May. The event, held in Oxford, is an invite-only tournament for those who achieved the classification of Junior Master Bowman during the previous year. The tournament comprised a 72-arrow ranking round followed by knockout Head-to-Heads.

In the combined Boys U16 and U18 Recurve event, **Marco Costanza** ranked 3rd in the qualification round and went on to finish 3rd in the Head-to-Heads. In the combined Girls U16 and U18 Recurve event, **Anna Perkins** ranked 7th in the qualification round and went on to finish 4th in the Head-to-Heads. And in the Girls U14 recurve event, **Ella Shield** ranked 8th in the qualification event and reach the quarter finals of the Head-to-Heads where she came up against the number 1 seed !

Other Recent Tournament Entries

Below is a summary of tournament entries by members of Cleve Archers during May. Anyone entering external tournaments who would like to see their efforts reported in a future Newsletter, please email details of their efforts to me – or even better, a copy of the Results List – as some clubs are not particularly timely with posting tournament results on their websites and your honourable editor doesn't have the time to trawl the internet to find them !



At the end of April on the 28th and 29th, **David Mortimer** entered Bath Archers Double WA 1440 event. In bitterly cold conditions, particularly on the Sunday when many archers didn't start or finish, David ended up finishing in 7th place in the Gents Recurve section and set himself a new PB for the Double !

Also on the weekend of the 28th and 29th, **Marco Costanza** took part in Archery GB's Key Event 1 in Hertfordshire. In the Boys Cadet section, Marco ranked 8th after qualification and reached the last 8 of the Head-to-Heads. Marco also made it through to the quarter finals of the Team and Mixed Team events.

The following weekend, at Lilleshall, **Marco Costanza** took part in Staffordshire Archery Associations' Bucks & Bounty tournament. On the

first day, Marco ranked 8th in the qualification round and finished joint 9th in the Head-to-Heads. On the second day, a double WA 720 event, Marco finished in 6th place.

Over the same weekend, **David Mortimer** was in the New Forest at Waterside Archers 720 H2H and WA1440 events. The weather was a complete contrast to the week before being uncomfortably hot ! In the 720 event, David ranked 14th after qualification in the Gents Recurve but went out in the 2nd round of the Head-to-Head. The following day in the Gents WA 1440 round David finished 12th. The organisers also produced a combined ranking which placed David in 20th position, largely due to the Head-to-Head showing.

On the weekend of 12th and 13th May, **David Mortimer** again found himself in Hampshire, this time at Andover Archers WA weekend along with

Adam Shaw. On the first day, archers show a Double 720 round and on the second day, a WA 1440 round. The final results showed Adam winning the Gents Compound section whilst David finished 11th in the Gents Recurve.

On Sunday 13th May, a number of archers from Cleve represented Gloucestershire in a friendly tournament against Worcestershire which, unfortunately, Worcestershire won. I have not yet obtained a set of results from this event, but when I do a report will appear in a future newsletter.

A week later on 19th May, four archers were in action in Cheltenham at Deer Parks WA 720 and Head-to-Head event. In the Gents recurve, **David Mortimer** ranked 12th and **Alec Thomas** 15th in the qualification event and both made it through to the last 16 in the Head-to-Heads. **Marco Costanza**

ranked 3rd in the Boys Cadet and finished 3rd in the Head-to-Heads and **Sophia Boulton** ranked 9th in the Ladies Compound and finished joint 9th.

The following day, also in Cheltenham, **David Mortimer** (Gents Recurve), **Will Hardy** (Boys Recurve) and **Ella Shield** (Girls Recurve) entered Black & Gold Archers Spring Tournament. David finished the day in 2nd place, Will also finished 2nd (Bristol 3) and Ella won her Bristol 4 event.

On the last Bank Holiday Monday in May, **David Mortimer** (Gents recurve), **Adam Shaw** (Gents Compound) and **Mark Humphries** (Gents Compound) shot at Meriden Archers WA 1440 event in the Midlands. Adam and Mark finished 8th and 21st respectively and David also finished in 21st in his event.

GDPR

I am sure most members are sick of hearing about GDPR, so I'll make this quick.

If you did not receive this newsletter via email through the club (e.g. another member has sent it to you or you've picked it up via the club website), this will be because your email address has been removed from the club's email list.

You will need to confirm (opt-in) via a club webpage (<http://clevearchers.co.uk/membership-opt-in/>) that you are happy for the club to send you emails about things that are not of "legitimate interest" (e.g. details of tournaments and club newsletters). If you do not opt-in, the club is only able to use your email address to send you information about things that are of a "legitimate interest" (e.g. AGMs, EGMs, membership renewals, closures of the field).

As of the end of May, 66 members had not yet opted-in (47 seniors, 19 juniors) so if you are one of these, please be aware that until you do opt-in, the club will only be sending you a limited range of information.
