Entrants may shoot any National round they wish but prizes will be depending on entries

For Adults & Junior Boys under 18

National – 4 doz at 60 yds & 2 doz at 50 yds

For Junior Boys under 16 and Junior Girls under 18

**National 50 – 4 doz at 50 yds & 2 doz at 40 yds**

For Junior Boys under 14 and Junior Girls under 16

National 40 – 4 doz at 40 yds & 2 doz at 30 yds

For Novice Archers & Junior Boys under 12 and Junior Girls under 14

**National 30 – 4 doz at 30 yds & 2 doz at 20 yds**

There will be four archers per boss in two details using foam bosses on H frames.
All arrows will be shot in ends of 6 in 4 minutes.

The ground behind the shooting line is prepared ready for our Shooting Shelter which we are hoping will be in place by the end of August

The information supplied will be held no longer than two years after the event to enable the tournament organiser to send Results from that year, contact you the following year with the event information or for the return of any trophies won.
