Archers Guidance

You must read and agree to follow all of the instructions listed in the archers guidance provided by Archery GB.

This is for the safety of yourself and others.

Cancellation Policy

Please only book slots where you will be able to attend, there are a lot of club members who wish to shoot. If you are aware that you will not be able to make a session please cancel your booking so that others may book the slot.

Health

Archers **MUST NOT** come to the Archery Range if they show symptoms of any illness, but in particular, Covid-19. These are highlighted on [NHS Direct](#) and include:

- A new persistent and dry cough
- A temperature

If you are symptomatic, living in a household with a possible COVID-19 infection or if you are classified as extremely vulnerable on health grounds, the guidance is that you should remain at home.

Archers must notify the club should they develop symptoms after attending the archery range.

Session

- You **MUST NOT** turn up to the range without a booking
- You **MUST NOT** arrive more than 5 minutes before the start time of your session, please arrive wearing and with the correct gear and be ready to shoot.
- You **MUST** ensure that you remain 2-meters away from other participants outside of your household at all times, including in the car park and behind the shooting line.
- You **MUST** depart the range within 10 minutes of the end time of your session, you should leave as soon as you have packed away your equipment.
- Please bring your own chair
- Please take all rubbish home with you

After the session, archers should sanitise their hands, clean their equipment and anything else used at the session.

Can you please bring your own hand cleanser with you and a disinfectant spray for your equipment and target frame?

In order to minimise contact, there is no need to remain at the club if you are not shooting.

No spectators are permitted, 1 carer may accompany a disabled archer if required, 1 parent/guardian may accompany a Junior archer (under 18).

Equipment

You must use your own equipment; you will not be allowed to borrow any club equipment including metal detectors. Sharing of equipment outside your household is not permitted. You must take all your equipment home. Individual archers must shoot at a single target but archers from the same household may share a target.

You should use target faces and target pins allocated to you by your club or provided by yourself. On your first visit to the club please take a target face and no more than 4 target pins, please take these home with you and bring them back for future sessions.

If you lose an arrow please do not waste time looking for it when others are trying to shoot in the limited time slots. Please report all lost arrows via our [contact form](#) or by emailing committee@clevearchers.co.uk.

Control of shooting

To reduce the risk to volunteers there will not be a range captain.

You must operate as a single shooting line across the field, one member should take control of the shooting using the commands "Shoot" and "Collect".

Facilities

There will be no club facilities, the kitchen will be locked to prevent contamination.

Toilets are to be used ONLY in an emergency, and therefore you should come prepared.
