Event Format:	There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details. Compounds will shoot at 40cm individual, 3 spot faces if 14 years or above. Full size 40cm faces for all other archers. Shooting will be in timed 3 arrow ends of 2 minutes. Both Session entries will only be included if tournament not full, 1 st Double Bray round only to count for results.
Awards:	Name of winner from each category will go into a draw; last name drawn will win a £60 Wales Archery Voucher.
Juniors:	Age for Junior Archers is as on the day of competition.
Dress:	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.
Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non - compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering the tournament Parents / Guardians are giving consent for junior archers (under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Refreshments:	A range of hot and cold drinks are available, along with cakes.
Photography:	People wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the Tournament Organiser. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child /
